**About the buyer:** The London Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games (LOCOG), invite expressions of interest for the supply of **medical equipment** to the emergency service department. Emergency Medical Services is one of five workstreams that comprise LOCOG Medical. Our goal is to provide comprehensive emergency medical care for all who attend the Olympic and Paralympic Games in London in 2012 whether they come as a competing athlete, official, VIP, Olympic family, workforce or spectator. The Olympics last 17 days and the Paralympics 11 days with a two-week build up when medical services will have to be provided totalling a period of over two months. We are planning our service to serve 26 Olympic sports with 11,200 athletes from 205 countries competing in 34 venues, followed by 20 Paralympic sports with 4200 athletes from 147 countries competing in 21 venues, and an estimated 9.2 million spectators. The EMS (Emergency Medical Services) staff will be volunteers, primarily recruited from healthcare professions. **About the Opportunity:** LOCOG is looking to appoint a supplier (or suppliers) to provide the equipment to support the provision of Emergency Medical Services. Emergency equipment will be supplied in three types

of medical kits (which will be used to treat different level of injuries), scoop stretchers, pat slides and other essential equipment commonly found in the provision of emergency medical services. The supplier (suppliers) should be able to supply emergency medical equipment packs customised exactly to LOCOG's requirements. The supplier (suppliers) should also be able to provide a stock supply of individual items for the replenishment of these medical packs. The bulk delivery is expected before the start of the Games in June 2012. The exact volume of the equipment has yet been finalised but current estimates indicate volumes of 600 individual response bags, 200 intermediate medical bags and 80 advanced trauma bags. The supplier (suppliers) should be able to provide sufficient equipment across competition and non-competition venues across the UK. All equipment needs to be CE and MHRA certified.
